



Scholarship Guidelines

Applications must be received no later than March 18, 2022.

- \$500.00 scholarships are awarded for one academic year. Student may reapply for subsequent awards.
- High school applicants must have attended a Linn County, Benton County, or Jones County High School and be a citizen of the United States.
- Applicants must apply and be admitted to an accredited University, College, Community College, Trade School or school of Higher Learning in the state of Iowa as a full-time student (12 credit hours or greater).
- A minimum 2.0 grade point (based on 4.0 system) is required.

Selection of awards based on: Financial need/Hardship, community involvement, special circumstances, academic plans and goals. Not a merit-based scholarship.

- Scholarship checks are written and distributed directly to students upon verification that the student has registered for fall semester. It is the responsibility of the recipient to submit this information to the scholarship committee prior to the recipient luncheon in July.
- Applications are available from school counselors and may be downloaded from crr Realtors.org/scholarship-program.
