# **Student-Athlete Guidelines and Procedures 2025-2026**

Athletic Behavioral Expectations - Students who are not in good behavioral standing will be subject to loss of eligibility based on the following guidelines.

- <u>Office Referrals</u> Students who receive office referrals during the competition season may face team or group consequences as determined by the coach or director. Examples include, but are not limited to, loss of starting positions, shortened playing time, extra conditioning, etc.
- <u>1st In-School or Out-of-School Suspension during the competition season</u> The student will be ineligible and thus not participate in the next scheduled competition or performance.
- <u>2nd In-School or Out-of-School Suspension during the competition season</u> The student will be ineligible and thus not participate in the next two scheduled competitions or performances.
- <u>3rd In-School or Out-of-School Suspension during the competition season</u> The student will be ineligible and thus not participate in the remaining scheduled competitions or performances. The student may also be dismissed from the current extracurricular activity.

### Academic Expectations:

• Students who are not in good standing in all their classes are considered ineligible for competitions or performances on a week-to-week basis. Students are encouraged to seek out their teachers to complete work and receive extra instruction in order to regain their eligibility.

### **Travel and Transportation:**

• <u>*Post-Game Travel*</u>: Students may ride home with their parents after an away game, provided the parent signs out their athlete. Students may only ride home with someone other than their parents if the coach has received prior communication and permission from the parent.

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### **Attendance Expectations -**

- Students must attend school for at least one-half day on the day of the activity, unless the administrator has granted permission for the student to be absent.
- Students will not be able to participate if they have a non-excused absence on the day of the event.

## **Equipment and Facilities:**

• *Lockers:* Students will be issued a school lock and locker, which must be used at all times. Personal locks are not permitted and will be removed.

### **Coach Supervision:**

• Coaches will remain on campus for 30 minutes after practices, games, or the team's return from an away contest.



#### **Final Authority:**

• The school administration reserves the right to make final determinations regarding acceptable conduct and adherence to these guidelines.
