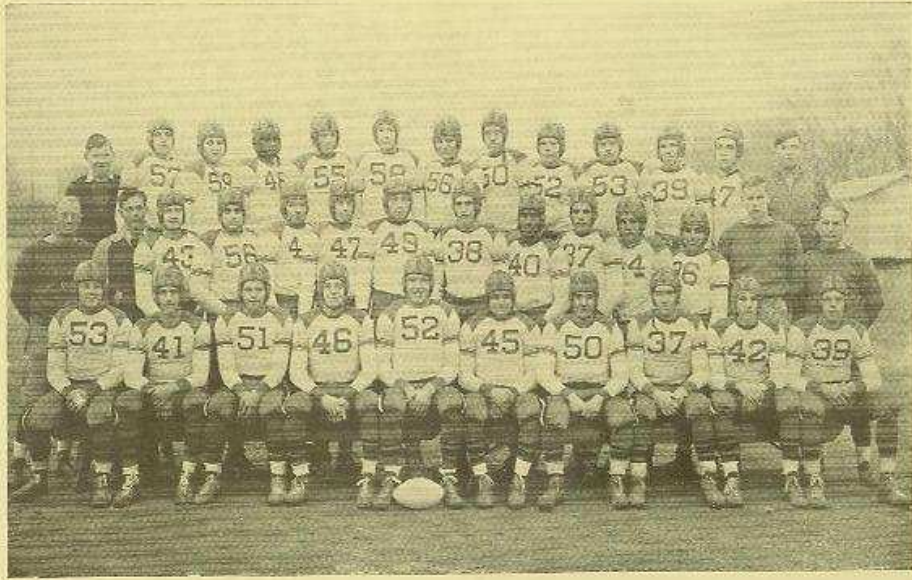

FOOTBALL

A decidedly successful gridiron season saw Roosevelt winning five games, tying three, and losing one, netting them the city championship, and a second place in the Mississippi Valley Conference.

The season opened with the Riders playing host to Rock Island, and amid a terrific heat wave, downed the Islanders 6 to 0 on a thirty-six yard touchdown sprint by Harold Briggs. Marshalltown was next on the Roughrider schedule and the extra point place kick of Ben Haddad's provided the Crimson and Black with a 7 to 6 margin, and the game.

The following week saw a lethargic Rider outfit playing host to the McKinley team, and barely escaped with a 6 to 6 tie. Smarting from this tie, they journeyed down to Centerville and copped a 13 to 0 win from the "Coal Miners." Incidentally, Roosevelt received a guarantee larger than has ever been given to any other school for going down to play the game.

Coming back home for the next encounter, Roosevelt won a sizzling 7 to 6 victory over its city rival, Franklin. Playing West Waterloo in the next round, the Rider outfit was completely demoralized and took a 19 to 0 shelling for their only defeat of the season. However, displaying superb courage, they came back strong to play their best game of the season the next weekend, and ran roughshod over Wilson High to the tune of 34 to 7.

The last two games of the season ended in ties, as a slow, unexciting 6 to 3 score was made in the East Waterloo game, while in the last game of the year a thriller was played against a potent Grinnell eleven, but a 13 to 13 score was the best the Riders could emerge with.

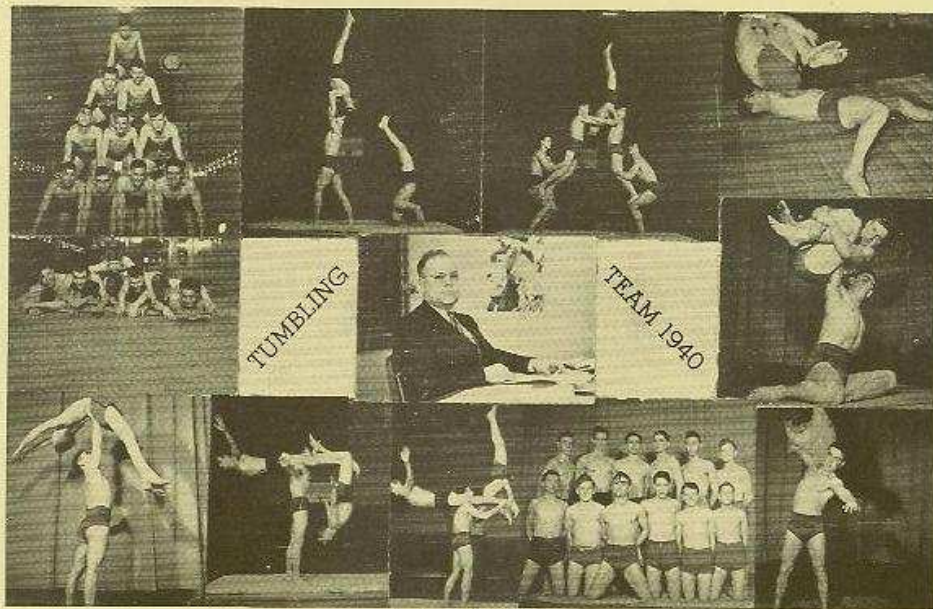

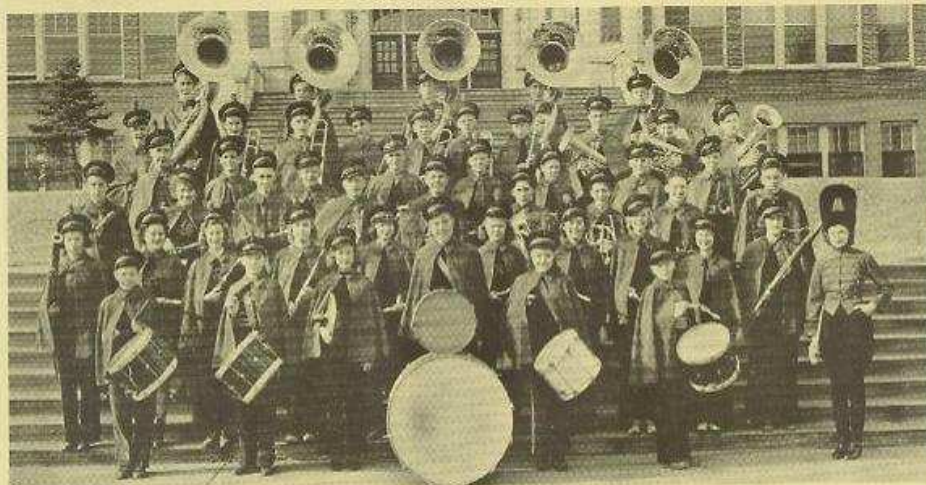
