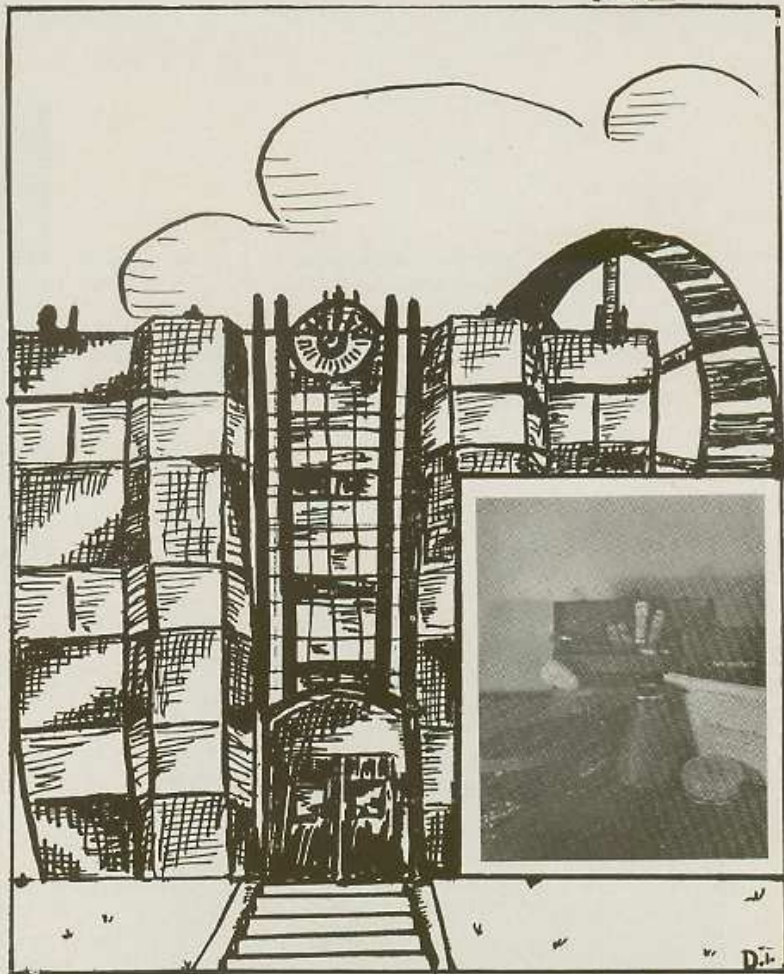
GOLF
