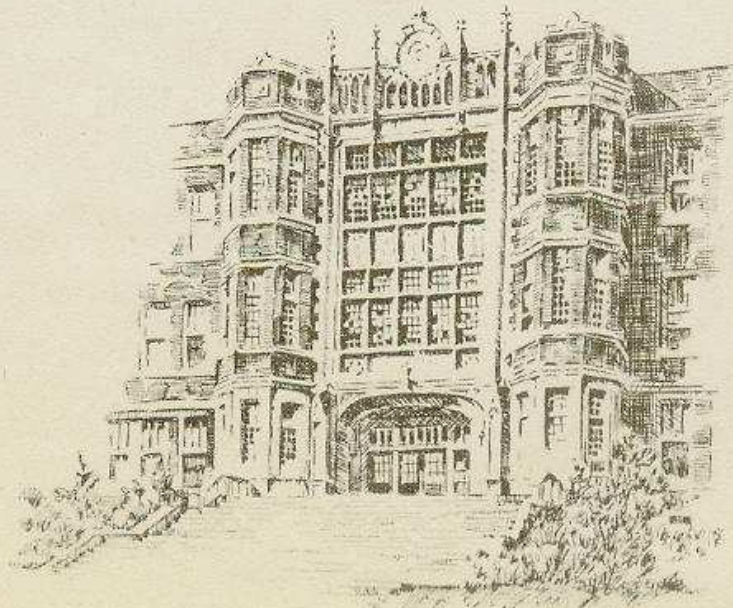

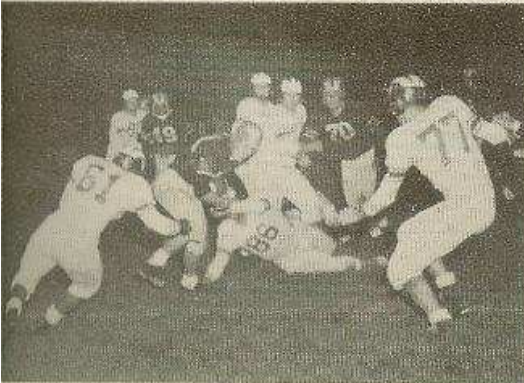


VARSITY ACTION
