ALTERNATE EXAMS FOR LATE TESTING

Reasons for which late testing will and will not be allowed are listed below. Only those students affected by the conflict may test late; all other students must test on the regularly scheduled date. Not all exams are available at the make-up time. When the cause of late testing is beyond the control of the school and the students, there is no additional fee. In other instances, when the students have a choice between testing on the scheduled date and requesting an alternate date, the student will pay an additional \$45 per exam, for a total of \$140, to partially defray costs. If a student participates in a conference, district or state activity, CRCSD will pay the late fee, **IF students notes the conflict on the online registration site.**
