Activities Director Report

- Lots going on in the next week. Youth basketball tournament 1/10. 1/14 girls wrestling, 1/15 basketball, 1/16 no school, 1/17 wrestling tournament, 1/18 youth wrestling tournament.
- Alumni golf tournament raised \$13,000 for Jefferson athletic teams. Proceeds also to Built by Pros, and Veterans organizations.
- Activities Secretary update: Had one but last day is 1-8. There is someone who was hired for a different position, but expressed interest in working with activities. Questions have been put out there about switching positions. Also looking at changing 'working' title to see if that will help.

Old Business

- Kingston foodtrucks
  - Moving forward, it was decided there will be a flat fee charged instead of a percentage of sales.
- Stocking concerns
  - Most recent Pepsi delivery was late and food delivery missed candies
  - Discussion on Inside stock vs Kingston stock
    - Questions on what we have and where. Conversation about trying to stock multiple locations. Square can track stock overall, but not in specific locations. B Janda is going to look further into this to see if there

are other ways it can assist. Historical data could be helpful but still needed to figure out how to access it.

## New Business

- 1/10 Youth BB Tournament - Tom's Coffee not in attendance so T Boll will grab coffee and creamer from Sam's for morning
- 1/17 Wrestling tournament - CD asked about donation or ordering drinks for the coach's room. Cheer has own hospitality space, but will be stocking
- Washington FB meal tickets finally figured out and Washington activities to be send invoice for \$108
- Square raising fees 1/13
  - Transaction fee going from \$.10 to .15 on each card.
  - We could lose upwards of \$800 due to costs rising if we don't change anything
    - Discussion of using BOUND instead. CDeam reached out to other ADs to get more information
    - Discussion on raising prices on items.
      - Concerns on prices and our student body.
      - New signage will be needed for all stands if changes made
- Softball concession stand conversation - K Kudej
  - M Fiala is not returning this season so wondering if updates could be made for the upcoming year. Coach hopes we can utilize tablets like in all other concession stands.
  - Could we help with some ordering food and it is requested to stop selling salmon, pretzels, and cheesecake bites (due to having to pick up in other towns)
  - Request to keep ribeye sandwiches and sundaes
- Mike Humphrey's passing. Booster club agreed to send flowers. TB ordered through HyVee for delivery
- Concerns with lack of staffing in stands
  - Several times we have been lacking staffing so it was either decided to not have hot food or to completely not open. KEirp has reached out to coaches to get parents to sign up but they are not. CDeam has asked if we need to close stand to be notified so he can tell the opposing teams.
  - STappsFee brought up message that IC Liberty sent out that does outreach to youth sport organizations where if they man booths for events, they can receive lump sum towards their organization. Could we reach out to Westside orgs? Jr J-hawks orgs? Etc?
