Results of student assessments are used to make critical decisions to meet the needs for students individually and as a whole in the Cedar Rapids Community School District. They measure and monitor student learning and provide feedback to students, educators, parents, and the community. To ensure that these assessments are fair for all students and that the results are reliable it is important that students follow certain guidelines while testing:

1. Follow all directions for your testing sessions.
2. All personal electronics must be turned off throughout testing and stored away from your testing area, in a locker, backpack, or purse, etc.
3. Prohibited behaviors include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Using personal electronics to capture test questions or responses.
 - b. Helping or accepting help from other students, which includes copying answers, using prearranged signals to provide answers, sharing used scratch paper, etc.
 - c. Discussing test questions or responses with students who have not yet tested.
 - d. Sharing test tickets or keeping test tickets or scratch paper after testing.
