- If you order senior swag online, some of those items will be available to pick up on the 2nd.
- Your gown will be delivered to the school in April

Diploma

- A Google Form will be sent to your school email address. All seniors must fill this out even if you are not participating in the graduation ceremony.
- Carefully enter the information. Make sure to enter your name exactly the way you want it to be printed on your diploma, including capital letters, periods, spacing, and commas.

- You do not need to have your formal name announced at graduation, but make sure to include what you want and how to say your name so Mr. Kline can get it right.
- Include a non-school email address. Your school email account will be closed in June.
- As a side note, plan to copy anything you want to save from your school Google account to another account before you graduate.

- If you do not receive the Diploma form in your email, check your spam or junk folder. You can also do a "search" in your Gmail account.



Requesting Transcripts

Official transcripts need to be sent FROM KENNEDY. This can be done a couple different ways depending on the college/university.


- Students may be able to include their Counselor's name and email and the C/U will send a notification for submission via other websites (Common App, SendEDU, Slate, etc)
- 2) Students should follow the instructions within XELLO to request your transcript to be sent.

Once sent, transcripts takes 2-3 days to process at the college level before anything will be marked received.

How Students Request Transcripts

Use Xello to request that your high school send a transcript on your behalf to the colleges of your choice, and then track the progress of your requests.



Access the College Planning Tools

To begin with, go to College Planning from the Goals & Plans link in the top menu or on the Dashboard.

This page is a central hub to view all the applications you're tracking, and local scholarships available. Or check out the Knowledge Hub with topics to help you plan for college.

Create an Application to Track

Click Create Your First Application to choose the college you want to track your application with.

If this isn't your first one, this page will be a list of your previous applications.

Use the search bar to enter the school name and click Select, then click Next.

On the next page, add details such as your application Admission Type and Deadline. Then click Create to begin tracking your application for this college. Send a Transcript

In the application tracker for the college, you'll see the Applications Checklist. Use this checklist to track the things you need to complete for the application.

From the list, where it says Transcript, click Request to request your high school send your transcript to the school.

If you don't see Transcript listed under the requirements, this college may not require it. You can still make a request by clicking Add Task and selecting Transcript.

View the Progress

View the status of your sent Transcript by opening the Application Tracker of the college you want to view.

From under Application Checklist, click the drop-down next to Transcript and select Track Transcript.

View the chronological updates of your transcript request.

FAFSA Info

- Any seniors planning to enroll in a college or university in the Fall of 2024
- Students (and parents) need to create FSA ID's at least 1 week prior to filing the FAFSA
- FAFSA will be available in December 2023

FSA ID Tips

- Use a personal email address (not school or work).
- Use your FSA ID annually when you access a FAFSA.
- Each FSA ID requires a unique email or mobile number; students and parents cannot use the same.
- It will take 1-3 days for the FSA ID to be usable to sign a FAFSA.

The FSA ID is required to complete FAFSA Application which is needed to Receive Federal and State Financial Aid.

Senior Information Hub

- Make sure to check out the announcements that are played daily and sent to your email. Important dates and information, like scholarship opportunities are posted there.
- There is a Senior Information page on the Kennedy Website. Bookmark the page and refer to it occasionally as it will be continually updated throughout the year. Some of the information found there include: Yearbook/senior pictures, CPR requirement to graduate, information on commencement ceremony, senior recognition night, ordering cap/gown/ class ring.
- Check your school email. Things like the Diploma Form will be sent by email.
