- If you cannot afford a cap/gown or have not ordered one, please see Mrs. Smith in the Main Office ASAP.



Graduation

If you have not ordered your cap and gown yet, do it today!

- Graduation rehearsal will be Friday, May 23rd at the Alliant Energy Powerhouse from 1:30-3pm.
- The graduation ceremony will be that evening.
- You MUST attend rehearsal to participate in the ceremony.
- Do NOT wear your cap/gown to rehearsal.
- Musicians will practice before this rehearsal and speakers will have a limited rehearsal time afterwards.
- You are responsible to get to the venue. Please be on time. Note, parking is not free and spaces are limited so you may want to carpool.

- The ceremony will start at 7pm. Doors will open at 6pm for students and 6:30 for friends and family.
- There is no cost and guests do not need a ticket for upper level seating. There is limited handicap seating.
- Tickets will be sold for reserved seating on the main floor.
- Joe Photo will be there to take pictures before and during the event. These can be ordered online.
- KCRG 9.2 will broadcast the ceremony.



- Dress appropriately, this is a formal event.
- No flip-flops or tennis shoes. You will have to climb stairs to get to the stage so beware of extremely high heels.
- No corsages or flowers.
- Do NOT decorate your cap or gown-if you do, it will be replaced.
- Please wear your medals, honor cords, and awards.
- If you can, please leave your cell phones and purses with someone you trust. You might not come back to the same seat after crossing the stage.

- All seniors are invited to attend. You can go to one or both of the events.

#### **Post Prom**

- Doors will open from 11-12 pm. No one may enter after midnight.
- If you leave, you will not be allowed to reenter.
- There will be catered food, games, inflatables, entertainment, and prizes.
- Wear comfortable athletic shoes and clothing.
- The pool will be open. Bring your own suit and towel.




#### Cost

- \$35 to attend BOTH prom and post prom
- Tickets will be sold BEFORE the event. There will be NO TICKETS sold at the door.
- Non-Kennedy guests MUST be registered by <u>Friday</u>, <u>April 25th</u>, NO EXCEPTIONS, NO LATE REGISTRATIONS.

- Guests must be at least in 9th grade and no older than 20 on the date of the event.
- Everyone must show an ID to enter. If you do not have an ID,
   Mrs. Neff can make one for you. The cost is \$5.
- All school rules apply to the event.
- If you leave the event, you may not reenter.

## **Good Student Policy**
