- -Sarah is looking for someone to help with the Booster Club taxes this year. She's asking her tax guy.

Shared info for new reps on the way the Booster Club raises money through running the concession stand and also the golf outing. Booster Club raises money through these efforts and then passes money to the Athletic Dept. Shawn then divvies that money out to coach's budgets based on parent volunteers. Every time a person volunteers he/she can say what sport they want the money to go to. For the golf outing, each sport is requested to do 4 things: 1) find a sponsor 2) find a foursome to golf 3) have a volunteer sign up to help at the event and 4) donate silent auction item(s) worth atleast \$100. The sport shares in the golf outing profit based on how many of these things they complete.

### **President's Report**

- -Dawn Peek will continue the Cougar Den apparel next year. Thanks to Dawn for doing the sale once again! The Holiday Sale profited \$654 for the Booster Club.
- -The Volunteer sign-up genius link for post-season (boys basketball) is available. There are two slots left for Friday night's game. If they win, we will host one more home game for the season. Annette and Whitney will clean up and close the concession area after those games.
- -Annette & Whitney are retiring at the end of this school year. Annette does the ordering side of things & Whitney does the actual concessions. The job is from August until March and pays \$538 per month (Whitney) and \$338 per month (Annette). Sarah discussed a possibility of her taking over Annette's portion of the job (with no pay), and then having 3-4 people take over Whitney's portion with paying a stipend of \$15/hr. (Based on current hours required, Whitney's role paid the equivalent of about \$13/hour this year.) This position would be offered to the 5 people that volunteered the most in the stand this year, plus a couple other individuals that have expressed interest in the position. We will discuss this more at the May meeting.
- -Sarah purchased another Square Terminal for the concession stand for \$319.93 and Todd reimbursed her.
- -The idea of paying for Lynn Groth a token of gratitude from the Booster Club was discussed. We agreed to discuss more at the May meeting.
- -This year's Golf Outing will be on July, 11th at Ellis. Sarah would like the profit goal to be \$50k this year. Attendees questioned if a morning and afternoon start would be possible. 9 holes vs 18 holes was discussed. Sarah is going to discuss those options with the Golf Pro but sticking with the same 18-hole, 10am shotgun start this year. Sarah is using a new app / website for registration this year, *Event Caddy*.
- -Jessica Stricker will take over the Silent Auction.

### **AD Report**

- -New coaches have been hired: Jacob Ciabatti and BJ White are co-coaches for girls track.
- -Track started today. 108 boys reported and 80 girls.
- -Reminder that Boys Bball postseason game tickets need to be purchased through Hometown Ticketing (not Bound). No student passes or punch cards.
- -Shawn expressed the need for bus drivers for activities. CDL would be needed, but the district would train people. He also shared the costs of buses and vans for teams to travel.

#### **New Business**

No update on an online KHS gear store.

-Brooke Arp is working on setting up an account at Stuff Etc where people could take items and the profit would go to the Booster Club. More info to come on that.
