i. Fourth grade: APPROVED This year Fourth Grade Students will be studying the Great Depression. Through their learning, they will do a great deal to learn about Herbert Hoover. We would like to take the entire Fourth Grade Student Body to West Branch to visit the Herbert Hoover Library and Museum in late April/Early May. 2 of the fourth grade classes will have a guided tour, while the other 2 classes walk the historical neighborhood, tour a one room schoolhouse, and visit the gravesites of the President Hoover and First Lady Hoover. Then, the two will rotate-allowing each group to see both aspects of the Museum/Library. Students will then eat lunch and return to school. Cost: \$360 for transportation (entrance fees are waived for students and teachers)
