

What is a magnet school?

Magnet schools give you a choice in where your student learns within the public school district. They adhere to state and district educational standards, but deliver instruction based on a theme. At City View, the theme is "community."

Who can attend City View Community High School?

Any incoming 9th or 10th grader in the area can apply. There are no requirements other than a desire to attend City View. Because seats are limited, only students who enter and are selected by a randomized lottery will be able to enroll.
