# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## *What is a magnet school?*

Magnet schools give you a choice in where your student learns within the public school district. They adhere to state and district educational standards, but deliver instruction based on a theme. At City View, the theme is “community.”

## *Who can attend City View Community High School?*

Any incoming 9th or 10th grader in the area can apply. There are no requirements other than a desire to attend City View. Because seats are limited, only students who enter and are selected by a randomized lottery will be able to enroll.
