ARE YOU IN GOOD STANDING? IF SO, THEN YOU CAN ATTEND!

GOOD STANDING

Students will be able to attend events if they meet all of the following criteria:

- Be failing no more than one class
- Accumulate less than six tardies per week.
- Maintain a minimum attendance rate of 80%
- Have no behavior referalls on record.

*Suspensions may impact a student's standing for an extended period, as determined by the Admin team.

BOOSTS

Students can reinstate their status by taking the following steps:

- Students who are not passing multiple classes must obtain verification from each teacher confirming they are making measurable progress towards passing.
- If a student is passing their classes by the time of the event, they may be eligible to attend with approval from a member of the Admin team.

Students must present their school ID at the event to verify status. Good standing is evaluated at the end of each one-week cycle.

Any student who is failing classes is required to attend a mandatory study table for two hours per week.

PROCEDURE

- Every Friday after school, an attendance and grade report will be generated.
- Students failing any classes will be required to attend Study Table the following week.
- Students not passing at least four classes, have an attendance rate below 80%, and/or accumulate six or more tardies in a week will be prohibited from participating in competitions for the following week. (Unless the student raises their grades to passing before the event, in which case they may regain eligibility)
- Students who do not complete the required two hours of study table will be ineligible for the next competitive event. Additional consequences will be determined on a case-by-case basis.

Furthermore, any unexcused absence will result in the student being unable to practice or participate in activities for that day.

STUDY TABLE

- Students are required to meet with their teachers to improve failing grades. They may work individually with teachers until 3:30 p.m. and must then report to study table from 3:30 to 4:00 p.m. with a pass from the teacher they were working with.
- Students must attend practice immediately following dismissal from the mandatory study table, provided they have a pass from the study table advisor and practice is in session.

*Students are required to attend until their grade reaches a passing percentage.

Students may appeal any decision by submitting a request to the Activities Director.
