



ACTIVITIES CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Franklin student-athletes are students first. They should complete teacher-assigned tasks before participating in activities.
 - a. Teachers may request students complete work outside of class before participating in a practice or competition.

2. Franklin student-athletes will attend and participate in practice every day they attend school. If they cannot attend a practice, parents must notify coaches to make it an excused absence.
 - a. If there are 2 or more unexcused absences from practice, this may result in removal from the team. (Unexcused absences are when a student is present at school but does not attend practice that day without parent notification.)

3. Franklin student-athletes represent Franklin Middle School in the best way possible, no matter the location.
 - a. If there are any behavior issues while on the bus or at an away competition, this may result in immediate removal from the team.

 - b. If a student is sent to the office on the day of a competition, they will NOT be allowed to participate in the competition.

 - c. If a student is suspended during the season, they will also be suspended from competition for as many days as the suspension from school. (Example: If a student is suspended for 2 days from school on Monday and Tuesday, they can practice but not participate in competitions for 2 days Wednesday and Thursday)

I understand that if I do not or cannot follow through on my commitments, there may be consequences such as less playing time, game suspensions, or removal from the team.
